Def. Thayer pg. 144: To hold discourse with others in order to instruct them. Deliver didactic discourses.

Authority over - auqentew (authento) Def.

Thayer pg. 84: To govern one, exercise dominion over.

A Woman's Role In The Work Of The Church

- ◉ **1 Corinthians 14:34-35** Let your women keep silent in the churches, for they are not permitted to speak; but [they are] to be submissive, as the law also says.
35 And if they want to learn something, let them ask their own husbands at home; for it is shameful for women to speak in church. (NKJV)

prophet when others
are speaking vs.30

Silent - sigaw (sigao)
Def. Thayer pg. 574:
To keep silence, hold
one's peace.

A Woman's Role In The Work Of The Church

- ⊖ **If these verses meant that women could not speak at all, or teach men at all in an assembly of the church, then:**
- ⊖ **Women can't sing** - *Colossians 3:16* Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord. (NKJV)
Ephesians 5:19 speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord, (NKJV)
