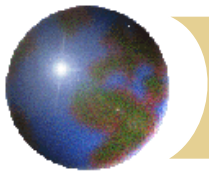




# *What Happened To The Dinosaurs?*

- ✦ *Dinosaur – “Terrible Lizard” 1841*
  - ✦ **Technically refers to giant reptile like land creatures**
  - ✦ **1825 called “Iguanodon” named after a tooth that looked like that of a giant Iguana.**
  - ✦ **1677 bones found were thought to be from extinct giant elephant.**
- ✦ *Dinosaurs were supposed to live (and die) 65 million yrs. Ago during the Mesozoic Era.*
- ✦ *Most people think all dinosaurs were huge creatures when in fact a relatively few number were huge and even evolutionists believe these were very old specimens. Many dinosaurs were quite small from the size of an ostrich to a chicken.*
- ✦ *Would T. Rex have eaten plants? What about the teeth and claws of the Giant Panda which mainly eats Bamboo*
- ✦ *Job 40:15; 41:1-34*



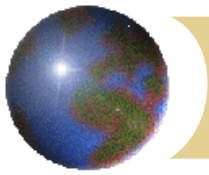

## ✚ **Many different cultures have dragon legends**

- 3000 bc Sumerian story Gilgamesh cuts off head of huge vicious dragon
- Alexander the Great finds – India – worshipping huge hissing reptiles they kept in caves.
- China has been renowned for their stories of dragons and it is featured prominently upon their art.
- England has story of St. George slaying a dragon.
- Tenth century story of an Irishman that has an encounter with what appears to be a *Stegosaurus*.
- 1500's European Science book *Historia Animalium* which list several animals as alive which to us are dinosaurs.
- 1572 a naturalist describes an encounter between a peasant and a dragon whose description matches that of a *Tanystropheus*.
