Are You A Disciple Of Jesus?

- Matthew 28:19-20 "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 "teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, [even] to the end of the age." Amen.
- Matthew 11:29 "Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.
- Acts 11:26 And when he had found him, he brought him to Antioch. So it was that for a whole year they assembled with the church and taught a great many people. And the disciples were first called Christians in Antioch.

A Disciple Listens To His Master

- Mark 7:14-16 When He had called all the multitude to [Himself,] He said to them, "Hear Me, everyone, and understand: 15 "There is nothing that enters a man from outside which can defile him; but the things which come out of him, those are the things that defile a man. 16 "If anyone has ears to hear, let him hear!"
- 1 John 4:6 We are of God. He who knows God hears us; he who is not of God does not hear us. By this we know the spirit of truth and the spirit of error.
- 1 Timothy 4:16 Take heed to yourself and to the doctrine. Continue in them, for in doing this you will save both yourself and those who hear you.
- John 15:14 "You are My friends if you do whatever I command you.
- Luke 6:46 "But why do you call Me 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do the things which I say?

A Disciple Is Teachable

- Acts 17:11 These were more fair-minded than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness, and searched the Scriptures daily [to find out] whether these things were so.
- Proverbs 15:31-33 The ear that hears the rebukes of life Will abide among the wise. 32 He who disdains instruction despises his own soul, But he who heeds rebuke gets understanding. 33 The fear of the LORD [is] the instruction of wisdom, And before honor [is] humility.
- Proverbs 25:12 [Like] an earring of gold and an ornament of fine gold [Is] a wise rebuker to an obedient ear.
- Proverbs 27:17 [As] iron sharpens iron, So a man sharpens the countenance of his friend.
- Proverbs 15:12 A scoffer does not love one who corrects him, Nor will he go to the wise.

A Disciple Is Like His Master

- Luke 6:40 "A disciple is not above his teacher, but everyone who is perfectly trained will be like his teacher."
- John 8:29 "And He who sent Me is with Me. The Father has not left Me alone, for I always do those things that please Him."
- Luke 9:57-62 Now it happened as they journeyed on the road, [that] someone said to Him, "Lord, I will follow You wherever You go." 58 And Jesus said to him, "Foxes have holes and birds of the air [have] nests, but the Son of Man has nowhere to lay [His] head." 59 Then He said to another, "Follow Me." But he said, "Lord, let me first go and bury my father." 60 Jesus said to him, "Let the dead bury their own dead, but you go and preach the kingdom of God." 61 And another also said, "Lord, I will follow You, but let me first go [and] bid them farewell who are at my house." 62 But Jesus said to him, "No one, having put his hand to the plow, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God."

A Disciple Tells Others Of His Master

- Acts 8:4 Therefore those who were scattered went everywhere preaching the word.
- John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
- Acts 8:35 Then Philip opened his mouth, and beginning at this Scripture, preached Jesus to him.
- Acts 10:42 "And He commanded us to preach to the people, and to testify that it is He who was ordained by God [to be] Judge of the living and the dead.
- 1 Thessalonians 1:6-8 And you became followers of us and of the Lord, having received the word in much affliction, with joy of the Holy Spirit, 7 so that you became examples to all in Macedonia and Achaia who believe. 8 For from you the word of the Lord has sounded forth, not only in Macedonia and Achaia, but also in every place. Your faith toward God has gone out, so that we do not need to say anything.

Therefore what shall we have?" 28 So Jesus said to them, "Assuredly I say to you, that in the regeneration, when the Son of Man sits on the throne of His glory, you who have followed Me will also sit on twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel. 29 "And everyone who has left houses or brothers or sisters or father or mother or wife or children or lands, for My name's sake, shall receive a hundredfold, and inherit eternal life.
