Matt 7:13-14 *“Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it.”*

Seeking The Way

- When Paul spoke of God to the people at the epicenter of world philosophy in Athens Greece, he introduced them to the God of all men about the reason God had created them:
 - **Acts 17:24-27** *“God, who made the world and everything in it, since He is Lord of heaven and earth, does not dwell in temples made with hands. Nor is He worshiped with men’s hands, as though He needed anything, since He gives to all life, breath, and all things. And He has made from one blood every nation of men to dwell on all the face of the earth, and has determined their preappointed times and the boundaries of their dwellings, so that they should seek the Lord, in the hope that they might grope for Him and find Him, though He is not far from each one of us;”*

Can You Tell The Truth from The Lie?

- God's wrath comes on people who suppress the truth of God for the lie.
 - **Romans 1:18-25**
- Jesus came into the world to testify of the truth.
 - **John 18:37-38**
- God will send a strong delusion so those who don't receive the love of the truth.
 - **2Thess 2:1-12**
- God has given us the means to figure out what is good and what is evil, however it requires effort on our part.
 - **Hebrews 5:13-14**

Scriptures Are Your Guide

- All scripture is given to train you in God's way.
 - **2Tim 3:16-17**
 - **John 14:4-6, 15-17, 25-26**
- A young person or someone new to the scriptures might ask "where do I start?". My advice is this:
 - Proverbs and Ecclesiastes should become second nature to you.
 - One way to accomplish this is to read the chapter in Proverbs equal to the date of the month every month for at least a year while also reading the book of Ecclesiastes through each month.
 - The reason I would start with these is because they were written specifically to guide about living in the world in a godly way.
