Take His Yoke Upon You

- **Learn From Him**

- **Matthew 11:29** "Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

- **Follow Him**

- **John 12:26** "If anyone serves Me, let him follow Me; and where I am, there My servant will be also. If anyone serves Me, him *My Father* will honor.

- **Be Like Him**

- **Luke 6:40** "A disciple is not above his teacher, but everyone who is perfectly trained will be like his teacher."
- **Luke 6:46** "But why do you call Me 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do the things which I say?

To This You Were Called

- **To Follow His Example**

- **1 Peter 2:21-25** “For to this you were called, because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that you should follow His steps:”

- **To Walk Like Him**

- **1 John 2:6** “He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked.”

- **To Walk In The Light**

- **1 John 1:7** “If we walk in the light the blood of Jesus Christ cleanses us from all sin.”

Walking In The Light

• What It Is Not

- Not living without sinning - John 1:7 But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.
- Not having no sin - 1 John 1:8 If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.
- Not having never sinned - 1 John 1:10 If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar, and His word is not in us.

• What It Is: Practicing The Truth

- 1 John 1:6 If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth.
- John 3:18-21 “For everyone practicing evil hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his deeds should be exposed. ²¹ “But he who does the truth comes to the light, that his deeds may be clearly seen, that they have been done in God.”

He Has Not Left Me Alone

- Remember One Statement:

Jesus Said in John 8:29

"And He who sent Me is with Me. The Father has not left Me alone, for *I always do those things that please Him.*"
