# How Good and Pleasant is Unity

- **Psalm 133:1-3** " Behold, how good and how pleasant it is For brethren to dwell together in unity! It is like the precious oil upon the head, Running down on the beard, The beard of Aaron, Running down on the edge of his garments. It is like the dew of Hermon, Descending upon the mountains of Zion; For there the Lord commanded the blessing— Life forevermore."

# Unity of Spirit Has a Bond of Peace

- **Ephesians 4:1-3** " *I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you to walk worthy of the calling with which you were called, with all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love, endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.*"
- **Proverbs 3:17** (Speaking of Wisdom)  
*"Her ways are ways of pleasantness, And all her paths are peace. "*

# Peace Must Be Sought After

- **Romans 14:19** *"Therefore let us pursue the things which make for peace and the things by which one may edify another."*
- **Hebrews 12:14** *"Pursue peace with all people, and holiness, without which no one will see the Lord:"*
- **Psalms 34:14** *"Depart from evil and do good; Seek peace and pursue it. "*

# Be Gentle, Kind & Tender

- **Colossians 3:12-14** *"Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering; bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do. But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection."*

# Forgiving One Another

- **Ephesians 4:31-32** *"Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and evil speaking be put away from you, with all malice. And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you."*

# Considering One Another

- **Ephesians 5:21** *"And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit, speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord, giving thanks always for all things to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, submitting to one another in the fear of God."*
- **Hebrews 10:24** *"And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works,"*
