"For what the law could not do in that it was weak through the flesh, God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, on account of sin: He condemned sin in the flesh, that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us who do not walk according to the flesh but according to the Spirit."

Romans 8:3-4, NKJV

Jesus Fulfills The Law & Prophets

- **Matthew 5:17-18** *"Do not think that I came to destroy the Law or the Prophets. I did not come to destroy but to fulfill. For assuredly, I say to you, till heaven and earth pass away, one jot or one tittle will by no means pass from the law till all is fulfilled."*
- **Jesus not only fulfilled the law and prophets by His own life but also preached to all who would listen to fulfill the whole law themselves.**

Encouraged To Fulfill The Law

- **The Golden Rule Is The Law & Prophets**
 - **Matthew 7:12** *"Therefore, whatever you want men to do to you, do also to them, for this is the Law and the Prophets."*
- **Fulfill The Whole Law**
 - **Matthew 23:23** *"Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have neglected the weightier matters of the law: justice and mercy and faith. These you ought to have done, without leaving the others undone."*

Go and Fulfill The Law

- **The Samaritan Who Fulfilled The Law**
 - Luke 10:25-37
- **Fulfill The Law With Righteous Judgment**
 - John 7:19-24
- **Jesus Gave Apostles Understanding of Law**
 - Luke 24:44-45 *"Then He said to them, "These are the words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that all things must be fulfilled which were written in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms concerning Me." And He opened their understanding, that they might comprehend the Scriptures."*

The Law Is Fulfilled In Two Commands

- **Matthew 22:36-40**

- **Love is fulfillment of law**

- **Romans 13:8-10** *"Owe no one anything except to love one another, for he who loves another has fulfilled the law. For the commandments, "You shall not commit adultery," "You shall not murder," "You shall not steal," "You shall not bear false witness," "You shall not covet," and if there is any other commandment, are all summed up in this saying, namely, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." Love does no harm to a neighbor; therefore love is the fulfillment of the law."*

Fulfill The Perfect Law of Christ

- **Galatians 5:13-14** *"For you, brethren, have been called to liberty; only do not use liberty as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another. For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself.""*
- **Galatians 6:2** *"Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ."*
- **James 1:25** *"But he who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues in it, and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does."*

A New Covenant

- **Hebrews 8:10-12** *"For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord: I will put My laws in their mind and write them on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. None of them shall teach his neighbor, and none his brother, saying, 'Know the Lord,' for all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them. For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more."*

The Law Is Able To Make One Wise

- **1Timothy 1:5-8** *"Now the purpose of the commandment is love from a pure heart, from a good conscience, and from sincere faith, from which some, having strayed, have turned aside to idle talk, desiring to be teachers of the law, understanding neither what they say nor the things which they affirm. But we know that the law is good if one uses it lawfully,"*
- **2Timothy 3:15** *"and that from childhood you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus."*
