Four Things Exceedingly Wise

⌘ Ants - Have little strength, but prepare their food in the summer

- Ants are contrasted with sluggards - Proverbs 6:6-11
- Sufficient for the day is its own trouble - Matthew 6:34

⌘ Coneys - Are feeble, but make their homes in the crags

- The cliffs are refuge for Coneys - Psalm 104:18
- The LORD is the rock of our refuge - Psalm 94:22

⌘ Locusts - Have no king, but advance together in ranks

- Each locust does his part - Joel 1:4; 2:7-8
- Every part should do its share - Ephesians 4:16

⌘ Lizards - Can be caught, but are found in kings palaces

- God knows we are but dust - Psalm 103:13-14
- But He prepares a place for us - John 14:2
